- Ensure you are compliant with the new laws which commenced on 29 September 2008 in most States/Territories.
- Develop a realistic fatigue management system Implementation Plan for whichever work/rest option you choose – standard hours, basic or advanced fatigue management.

- Achieve HVAS accreditation in either basic or advanced fatigue.
